



The school's college prep curriculum provides students with Advanced Placement and dual enrollment/dual credit early college access. In addition to rigorous academics, the school boasts extensive after school opportunities in athletics, arts, and academics to support holistic development of students. Students are supported with wrap around services including homework help, tutoring, and a Summer Prep program. A robust college and alumni program has ensured that since its first graduating class, 100 percent of graduates have been accepted to college. Today, over 90 percent of graduates enroll in college, a testament to the school's mission.
