NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

Access and Burglar Alarm Systems

Thurgood Marshall Academy—a nonprofit, college-preparatory, public charter school located in Southeast Washington, DC—seeks one or more contractors to furnish security systems.

Summary of Scope:

Vendors have the opportunity to bid on some or all of the following needs:

1. Replace access (RFID) system at the end of its useful life with a modernized system.
2. Replace burglar alarm system at the end of its useful life with a modernized system.
3. As add-alternate, propose improved visitor ID system.

Full RFP:

To ensure fairness to all bidders, no questions or requests will be accepted by phone.

To receive the full RFP, ask questions, and be included in bid communications, **email proof of qualifications as a security system vendor** to: dschlossman@tmapchs.org no later than Thursday, April 18, 2019.

Site-Visit:

A bidders' conference will be held on Wednesday, April 10, 2019.

RSVP and proof of qualification as a security system vendor required for attendance.

Special Conditions & Information:

- The project will be funded by federal funds (as detailed in the full RFP).
- By bidding, vendors agree to comply with all applicable regulations, including but not limited to the following:
 - Equal Opportunity Employment
 - Non-debarment for receipt of either federal or DC funds
 - 2 CRF 200 applicable regulations
 - Davis-Bacon Act
 - Copeland “Anti-Kickback” regulations
- By bidding, vendors agree to Thurgood Marshall Academy’s General Conditions Statement (details appear in the full RFP) with the exception of DC CBE (since federal regulations prohibit geographic preferences).
- Amendments/changes (if any) to the RFP—including but not limited to deadline extensions—will be sent solely by email to vendors furnishing proof of qualifications.
